**“5 datos sobre la Pascua que todo católico debe saber** — “Con la Resurrección de Cristo se inicia un tiempo litúrgico muy especial en la Iglesia llamado Pascua, cuyo origen data de muy antiguo y que cuenta con diversas tradiciones. **1.** Surgió con pastores Los orígenes de la Pascua se remontan a las fiestas de antiguos pastores nómadas o seminómadas que hace unos 4000 años se celebraban fuera de un santuario, sin sacerdote ni altar. Se mataba y cocinaba un animal joven, sin romperle ningún hueso. Con la sangre se untaban los palos de las tiendas como una protección contra los peligros. **2.** ¿De dónde proviene la palabra? De acuerdo a la Biblia, Pascua viene de la raíz "psh" que significa cojear, andar en muletas o saltar. Esto en referencia a que Dios se saltó u omitió de la muerte a aquellas casas judías que habían marcado sus puertas con la sangre del cordero. En el hebreo, Pascua se pronuncia "Pesach o Pésaj", y significa "paso". Es decir, recuerda el paso del Señor por aquellas casas marcadas, el paso de Israel por el Mar Rojo y el paso de la columna de fuego que guiaba a los judíos liberados de Egipto por el desierto. En inglés, se dice "Easter". Según la Enciclopedia Católica, el historiador y doctor de la Iglesia San Beda relacionó esta palabra con "Estre", quien era "una diosa teutónica de la luz naciente del día y de la primavera" **3.** Controversias por la fecha Jesús celebró la última Cena en la fiesta de la pascua judía; es decir, el 14 del primer mes, llamado "Nisán", del calendario judío. El detalle es que ese calendario es lunar y tiene 354 días, mientras que el calendario actual es solar y cuenta con 365 días, por ello resultaba difícil hacer coincidir las fechas. Además, cada 4 años los judíos intercalaban un mes a su calendario por decisión del Sanedrín. Todo esto llevó a varias controversias entre los cristianos para definir la fecha de la Pascua. Incluso en algunas zonas se celebraba que Jesús murió el 25 de marzo y resucitó el 27..." (<https://www.aciprensa.com/noticias/99031/5-datos-sobre-la-pascua-que-todo-catolico-debe-saber>).
