Lower church fire alarm system... Sometime over the next month, the lower church will be closed for a week due to the need to replace portions of the fire alarm system. One component which must be replaced has a date on it going back to 1937! Obviously, we cannot put off this upgrade to the system and it shows the necessity for regular maintenance and update of our facilities. The cost will be between \$12,000 and \$15,000 depending upon contingencies. During the period of the closure of the lower church, all liturgical activities will be in the upper church.

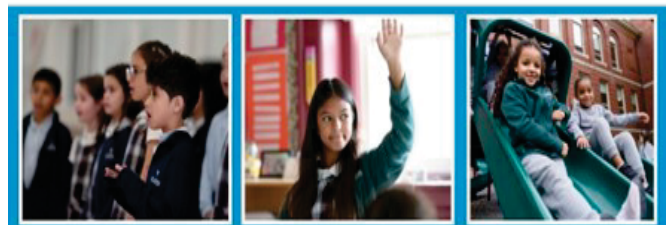

“5 datos sobre la Pascua que todo católico debe saber — “...No obstante, desde el I Concilio Ecuménico de Nicea en el año 325, la Semana Santa se celebra el primer domingo de luna llena después del equinoccio primaveral en el hemisferio norte y equinoccio otoñal en el hemisferio sur (alrededor del 21 de marzo). Cabe resaltar que la pascua judía no es igual a la Pascua cristiana. Los primeros aún celebran la liberación de la esclavitud de Egipto. Los católicos, en cambio, festejamos la Resurrección de Cristo que libera del pecado y de la muerte. **4.** Son 50 días La Pascua católica es la principal fiesta del año litúrgico. El Papa San León I la llamaba la fiesta máxima (*festum festorum*). Se celebra durante 50 días, desde el domingo de Resurrección hasta el de Pentecostés. Los primeros 8 días se conocen como la "Octava de Pascua" y se celebran como solemnidades; es decir, como si cada uno de estos días fuera un "Domingo de Resurrección". **5.** La vestimenta y las oraciones En la Pascua, la casulla y la estola de los sacerdotes, así como los manteles del altar y del ambón son de color blanco, que simboliza el espíritu de fiesta, la alegría y el júbilo. Asimismo, durante este tiempo el rezo del Ángelus es reemplazado por el Regina Coeli (Reina del Cielo), en el que se anima a la Virgen a que esté alegre por la resurrección de su Hijo.” (<https://www.aciprensa.com/noticias/99031/5-datos-sobre-la-pascua-que-todo-catolico-debe-saber>).
