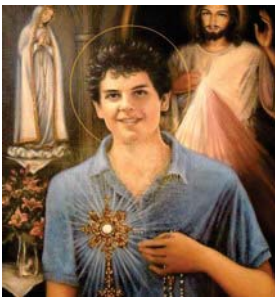

Couples planning marriage should make arrangements at least **SIX MONTHS** prior to the wedding date.

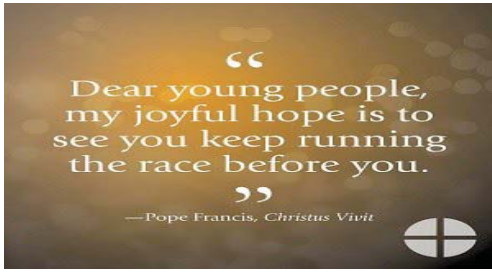

April is Child Protection Month

Did You Know?.... Five Steps to Safer Environments

The Archdiocese of Boston mandates that all people who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools must undergo child abuse prevention training through the VIR-TUS program. Come to a Protecting God's Children training to learn about the warning signs of an inappropriate relationship with a child, and how to help keep all kids safe. The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse:

Know the warning signs!

Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.

Monitor all programs for the safety of children and youth.

Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children.

Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.



2nd Sunday of Easter

The readings all during Lent have been teaching us the basics of a spiritual life. They form a catechism that shows us how we grow in faith. EL SANTO DE
LA SEMANA

Faustina Kowalska

25 de agosto de 1905 – 5 de octubre de 1938

Día de fiesta—5 de octubre

En el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, celebrado el fin de semana después de la Pascua, el Evangelio nos narra la historia de cuando Jesús se les apareció a los discípulos en el cuarto cerrado en donde ellos estaban escondidos.

Juan 20:19-23

Al anochecer del día de la resurrección, estando cerradas las puertas de la casa donde se hallaban los discípulos, por miedo a los judíos, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos y les dijo: “La paz esté con ustedes”. Dicho esto, les mostró las manos y el costado. Cuando los discípulos vieron al Señor, se llenaron de alegría. De nuevo les dijo Jesús: “La paz esté con ustedes. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío

yo”. Después de decir esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A los que les perdonen los pecados, les quedarán perdonados; y a los que no se los perdonen, les quedarán sin perdonar”.

Esta semana reconocemos a Santa Faustina como la Santa de la Semana, aunque su fiesta es celebrada en octubre, debido a su cometido de propagar el mensaje de la Divina Misericordia. En muchas ocasiones, Jesús se le apareció y le habló de su gran e incommensurable misericordia hacia aquellos que confían en él. Jesús le dijo a Santa Faustina que él deseaba que el domingo después de la Pascua se celebrara como una “Fiesta de Misericordia”, como un refugio para todas las almas, especialmente, para los pobres pecadores.

Santa Faustina nació en 1905 en el seno de una familia polaca pobre y, a una temprana edad, experimentó un llamado religioso. Al principio, ella aplazó su deseo de cumplir con su vocación religiosa a fin de ayudar a su familia económicamente trabajando como sirvienta. A los 19 años, después de una visión del sufrimiento de Jesús, Faustina buscó fervientemente su ingreso a la vida religiosa. Al principio, muchos de los conventos la rechazaban pero, en agosto de 1925, ella logró ingresar a la orden de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia. Luego, en abril de 1928, hizo sus primeros votos en presencia de sus padres.

Santa Faustina sirvió a la Congregación en Cracovia, Plock y Vilna como cocinera, jardinera y portera. Mientras vivía una vida religiosa sencilla, creció en gran unión con Dios, experimentando profundos sufrimientos y

consuelos. Ella tuvo muchas visiones de Jesús y escribió un diario contando sus experiencias. Santa Faustina falleció de tuberculosis en 1938, a la edad de 33 años.



En 1959, el Vaticano suspendió la devoción a la Divina Misericordia. Pero, en 1978, la Santa Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe levantó la suspensión después de que nuevos documentos originales fueran examinados y los textos vueltos a traducir. En ese entonces, el Cardenal Karol Wojtyła promovió enfáticamente el mensaje de la Divina Misericordia. Luego, ya como Papa Juan Pablo II, él canonizó a Santa Faustina en abril del 2000 y designó el Segundo Domingo de Pascua como el

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Debido a su labor que fomentaba la devoción a la Divina Misericordia, a Santa Faustina se le conoce como el “apóstol de la Divina Misericordia”.

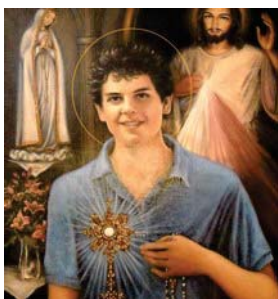

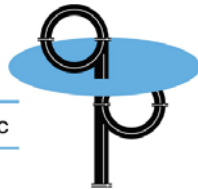

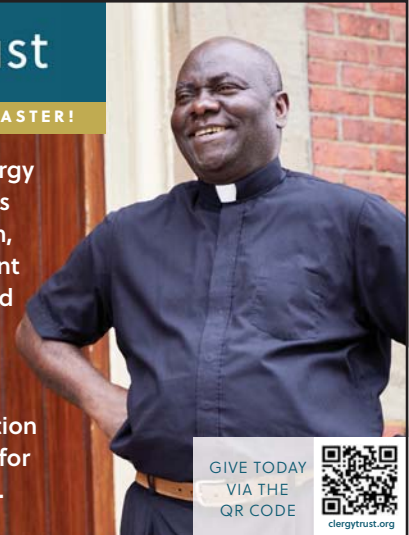
